MOTION TO STRIKE

Pursuant to Sections 4(i) and 4(j) of the Communications Act,¹ the Fixed Wireless Communications Coalition (FWCC), a coalition of companies, associations, and individuals interested in the Fixed Service,² moves the Commission to strike from the record the italicized words in the following passage as untrue, incivil, defamatory, and offensive to the dignity of these proceedings:

The Commission's unabashed desire to cleanse the C-band of ESVs... *kowtows to the unsubstantiated paranoia and irresponsibly unrealistic refusal* of the [Fixed Service] industry to share the burden of maximizing the efficient use of the radiofrequency spectrum.³
